# FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN, PASTOR

This week, we will celebrate the feast of St. Mary Magdalene, penitent. This past September, I was blessed to be able to visit the cave where she spent the last 30 years of her life, in Provence France, a good hike up into a mountainside. Inside the cave, there are various shrines and places to pray. The view down the mountain was amazing, but the peace inside the cave was unforgettable. If you ever get to visit there, you must drive up the mountain a considerable distance, then get out and hike about 45 minutes up one of the various trails that lead to the sanctuary. It is a popular spot for the French. Bl. Charles de Foucault visited there before departing from Marseilles to Algiers. There is a shrine to him in the same cave.

The skull of St. Mary Magdalene is kept down the mountain in the Basilique Sainte-Marie-Madeleine de Saint-Maximin-la-Sainte-Baume. This is another very special and prayerful place to visit. Her prayerful intercession and beautiful soul are a powerful gift to the Church.
