We enter Ember Week in September. Ember Days are an opportunity four times per year to consecrate each of the four seasons to the LORD. This Wednesday, Friday and Saturday are days of fasting and penance. Wednesday and Saturday are days of partial abstinence (one meal with meat may be taken). Friday is a day of full abstinence from meat.
