FROM THE DESK OF FR ERIC ANDERSEN

We have various projects in motion, which pertain to the maintenance and restoration fund. We also have an opportunity to purchase a side altar of the Sacred Heart for the chapel which is available for a very reasonable sum of \$14,000. Shipping would be an additional \$1,800. It would arrive in six pieces and be reassembled in the side chapel. It is 8 feet across and 13 feet high and it matches the architectural style of the church. The original side altar in the chapel was removed after Vatican II. I am including a photo here for your perusal. If you would like to help sponsor this

project, it would be a fitting replacement for the original one.

Other projects include:

• Street tree removal (2 trees) & maintenance of 35 trees: \$20,000

Security fencing/gates: \$50,000

- Security cameras/video, etc: \$10,000 installation plus monthly fee
- Repair and re-painting of Saint Stephen statue: \$1,800 (the statue is already sponsored)
