His Excellency, the Most Reverend Archbishop Alexander K. Sample, will celebrate a Solemn Pontifical Mass at the Throne according to the *Usus Antiquior* of the Roman Rite at 7 pm on Monday, August 2nd, 2021 to kick off the Eucharistic Conference and Parish Mission here at St. Stephens. PHILOSOPHY NIGHT – Tuesday August 24 at 7:00 PM Topic: "What is Usury?"

Description: In our current debt-based economy, it is hard to understand the Church's teaching that usury (or charging interest on certain types of loans) violates the Seventh Commandment. Adding to the confusion is the fact that much of the written Magisterium on usury long predates the introduction of modern economic terms like 'inflation' and 'opportunity cost'. In this philosophy night, a St. Stephen's parishioner with a background in law and economics will try to work through what kinds of loans would be--and would not be--usurious, and will consider what a hypothetical society without usury could look like. No reading ahead necessary. Ages high school and up. Snacks provided. Meet in Rectory Basement.
