VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY: FLOWERS

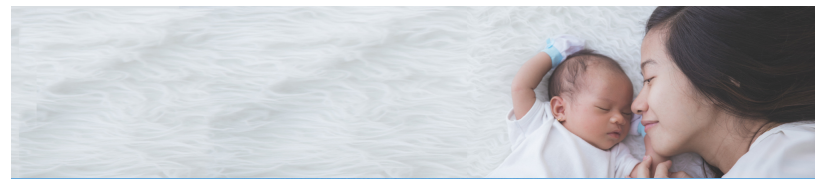
