This time of the liturgical year is filled with solemnity after solemnity to almost exhaust us before we settle down for a nice rest during the month of July. This week, we have the Vigil of St. John the Baptist, with the blessing of a bonfire for the disposal of worn out or damaged religious articles. There is a famous hymn in the Divine Office and the Bonfire Blessing: *Ut Queant laxi;* written in the 8th century for the feast which led many centuries later to the development of the musical scale by Guido of Arezzo. Ergo, St. John the Baptist becomes a patron saint of singers, especially those who have lost their voices, that their suppleness of voice may return.

Additionally, July 1st is the Feast of the Most Precious Blood of Our Lord, Jesus Christ. July is the month of the Precious Blood. Please join me in praying a novena before the feast.
